




# Downtown Chicago Transit Map



**Regional Transportation Authority**  
 The Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) provides financial oversight, funding, and regional transit planning for the three public transit operations in Northeastern Illinois: The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA), Metra and Pace bus and paratransit. The Agency provides customer services including telephone travel planning assistance and travel training for people with disabilities. The RTA is the only transit agency that focuses on the entire region when determining transit planning and funding. The RTA region has a population of approximately eight

**Bikes On Transit**

CTA and Pace provide bus service throughout the Chicagoland region. Customers can put their bikes on bus bike racks located on the front of buses. Bikes are permitted on CTA trains except during weekday rush periods.

**Accessibility**

Metra has 243 commuter rail stations, of which 190 are fully accessible and 11 are partially accessible. The CTA "L" train system includes 145 stations, of which 103 are fully accessible. All CTA and Pace buses are ramp-equipped and make automated stop announcements. 


**CTA Route 19: United Center Express**

Operates daily, 8:30 am to 10:30 pm. Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day, runs 90 minutes later in both directions.

**CTA Route 128: Soldier Field Express**

Service for Bears football games only. Buses leave stations starting 2 hours before game time until 30 minutes after kickoff. From Soldier Field, every few minutes for 1 hour after game; board on McFetridge. Round trip fare \$5 (\$2.50 reduced fare).



**CTA Route 130: Museum Campus**

Operates from Memorial Day through Labor Day every 15 minutes, from 9:30 am to 6 pm.

**CTA and Pace Fares**

New Ventra® cards cost \$5 at Ventra vending machines. Add account value using Ventra App, cash, coins, or bankcard at any Ventra vending machine, or with credit/debit cards online and by phone. Ventra Cards and passes can be added to an iPhone, Apple Watch, or to an Android device with Google Wallet.

Cash is accepted on buses. No transfers are issued when paying cash.
