



Vintage Tram 42 – Hop-On Hop-Off. 24-hour ticket: Adults CZK 400, Children/Students/Seniors CZK 300. Kids under 5 ride free.

SUPERIOR TOUR OF PRAGUE

Full day in Prague on foot, by river boat and by tram

Daily, starting at 11am with optional free pickup from your hotel at 10:30am. This six-hour tour includes a good lunch, drinks, a little Venice Prague cruise and a tram ride.



This walk is a unique combination of the best aspects of each of our walks. Moving from the magical little web of alleys in Old Town past the crucial milestones in the history of the Jewish Quarter and Wenceslas Square in New Town, the site of astonishing protests and uprisings, we come to the river. Here we can enjoy a comfortable cruise that shows us the most romantic spots of Prague, such as Lesser Town, from the most unusual angles. Then we board the tram to ascend the hill to Prague Castle, the real heart of Prague. Your guide will take you through all the courtyards and show you the architectural gem of St. Vitus Cathedral.

The tour ends at the Prague Castle complex close to the Lesser Town metro station "Malostranská". You can take the metro or tram back to your hotel. Also, if you wish, our guide will gladly navigate you back to the centre or another place you might wish to go.

FINISHING POINT

Transfers sign umbrella. Please turn up 10 minutes before the walk starts. Locations in Prague. 
METRO

Prague Metro operates daily from 5am to midnight. On Fridays and Saturdays, service runs about one hour longer, until around 1am. The time interval between train departures is approximately 3 minutes during the workday rush hours and 5-10 minutes during off-peak hours. The Prague Metro network consists of 3 lines designated by letters and differentiated in colour (Green colour – line A, Yellow colour – line B, Red colour – line C).

TICKETS

CZK 120 pass Valid for 24-hour pass
CZK 330 pass Valid for 72-hour pass
CZK 30 ticket Valid for 30 minutes
CZK 40 ticket Valid for 90 minutes

Public transport tickets can be used on any type of public transport and allow transfers between lines and types of transport (metro to tram, tram to bus, etc.).



TICKET VALIDATION

If not purchased directly on board, tickets must be validated before travel at entrance gates in metro stations, or using the small yellow validators on trams and buses.
