### DID YOU KNOW?

Priority Card: To receive a Priority Card, anyone who is officially registered as disabled must present a government or Medical Authorities official document to one of our information desks. This card grants priority access to our attractions, shows, shops and restaurants, although access is not immediate. The official list of proof documents accepted at Disneyland Paris is available on <a href="https://www.disneylandparis.com">Disneylandparis.com</a> .	
To receive a bracelet giving priority access to certain attractions and shows, expectant mothers can go to any of our information desks and present a proof of pregnancy.	
All of our shows, most of our shops and some attractions have a magnetic loop. Find them by looking out for this symbol.	
Guide and assistance dogs are welcome at Disneyland Paris. Please use the green spaces for them to do their business and clean up after them. Find accessible attractions by looking out for the symbol or use Rider Switch.	
Rider Switch is a free service that allows parents with young children, guests unable to go on the attraction or a guide or assistance dog to take turns on certain attractions without having to wait in line a second time! Enquire at the attraction entrance.	
All our restaurants have menus with Audio Description using the free AudioSpot app. The Audio Description service will start automatically when you approach a restaurant. Bon appétit!

Instead of carrying your purchases around with you, use our Shopping Service and collect them before the Park closes.
