

GOLDEN GATE PARK + PRESIDIO

With more than 1,000 acres to explore, the park starts where Haight-Ashbury ends and continues to Ocean Beach. Explore museums and landmarks, the giant redwoods, trails, lakes, windmills and gardens. Several of the city's most visited attractions are within steps of one another, easily accessible via public transportation or by parking in one location. The Presidio, a former military base at the mouth of the Golden Gate, is another enormous protected space where nature roams free.
